

ORDINANCE NO 46

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BEAVERTOWN, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A CURFEW DURING THE MONTH OF OCTOBER OF EACH YEAR WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE 30TH AND 31ST DAY THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Beavertown as follows:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. The following words and phrases shall have the meanings ascribed to them herein, unless the context of the ordinance clearly indicates other wise:

- (a.) CHILD shall mean any natural person under the age of eighteen (18) years.
- (b.) SCHOOL CIVIC OR RELIGIOUS FUNCTION shall mean any sporting, forensic or musical event or rehearsal therefor, sponsored and sanctioned by the Mid-West School District, or any community or religious organization.
- (c.) EMERGENCY ERRAND shall mean any errand necessary to protect human or animal life or limb.

SECTION 2. PROHIBITED ACTS. It shall be unlawful for any child to be in or upon the streets, alleys, sidewalks or public places within the Borough of Beavertown, during the month of October of each year, excepting the 30th and 31st days thereof, after the hour of 9:00 P.M. prevailing time, except in the following circumstances:

- (a.) Such child is accompanied by his parent or guardian.
- (b.) Such child is coming from or going to his place of employment.
- (c.) Such child is coming from or going to a school, Civic or religious function.
- (d.) Such child is on an emergency errand.

SECTION 3. PENALTY FOR VIOLATION. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof before any District Magistrate or Justice of the Peace, shall be ordered to pay a fine to the Borough of Beavertown of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) plus costs of prosecution.
